

10.4 TABLE OF MONEY ORDER SERVICE

Remittance by money order is available to the countries shown in the following :

<i>COUNTRY/ TERRITORY</i>	<i>MAXIMUM AMOUNT FOR A SINGLE ORDER</i>	<i>REMARKS</i>
The Philippines	US\$5,000	<p>(i) The remitter may choose to deposit the amount of money order to the payee's bank account direct.</p> <p>(ii) Philippines Postal Corporation will convert the US\$ remittance into equivalent amount of Peso when accepting and paying the remittance. The exchange rate of US\$ will be sent by Philippines Postal Corporation.</p>
The Mainland of China	US\$1,000	<p>(i) The remitter and payee must be an individual and not a company or an organization.</p> <p>(ii) The remitter may choose RMB or US\$ for payment to the payee. If RMB is chosen, the payee can only receive RMB. If US\$ is chosen, the payee can choose to receive either US\$ or RMB after receiving the notification of remittance collection. The exchange rate from US\$ to RMB will be based on such rate as announced by the People's Bank of China on the date of payment. The payee can collect RMB at a designated post office nearby or US\$ at a designated post office in the major cities. Japan	US\$ 5,000	<p>(i) Remittance made in Hong Kong will be converted from Hong Kong Dollars to US Dollars equivalent and then remitted to Japan. The currency to be collected by recipients is Yen.</p>

Nepal	US\$ 2,000	(i) Remittance made in Hong Kong will be converted from Hong Kong Dollars to US Dollars equivalent and then remitted to Nepal. The currency to be collected by recipients is Nepalese Rupees.
Indonesia	US\$ 2,000	(i) Remittance made in Hong Kong will be converted from Hong Kong Dollars to US Dollars equivalent and then remitted to Indonesia. The currency to be collected by recipients is Indonesian Rupiah.
